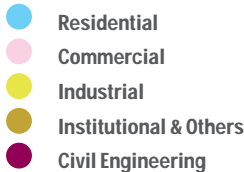
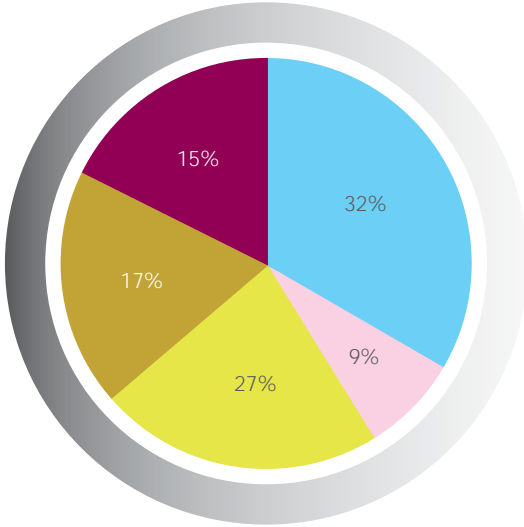
## Construction GDP- at 2000 Market Prices



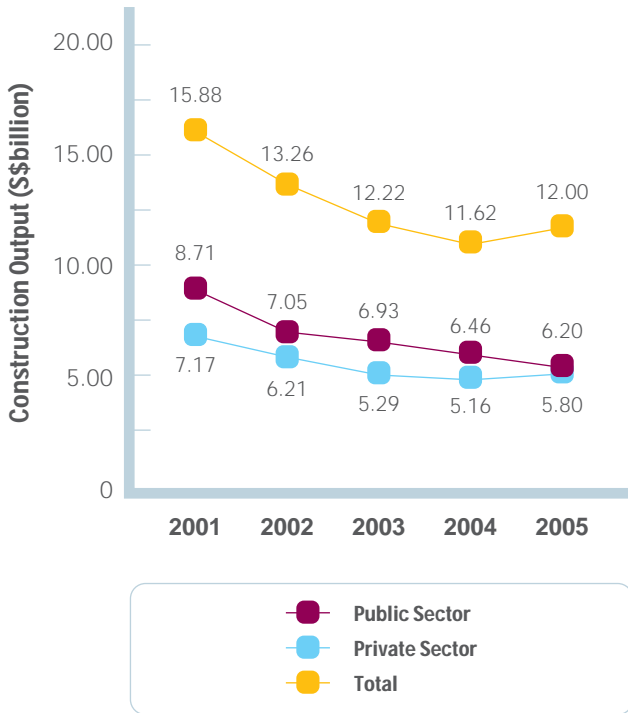
## Construction Demand



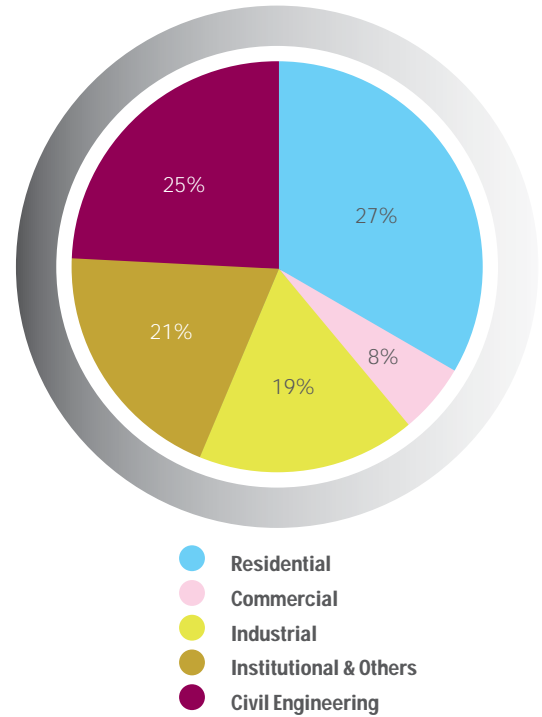
## Construction Demand in 2005



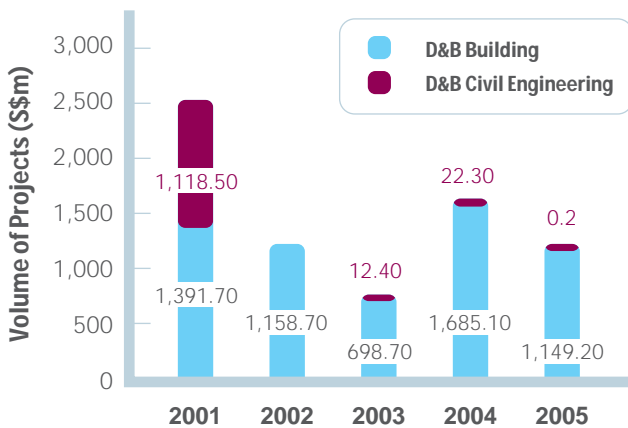
## Construction Output



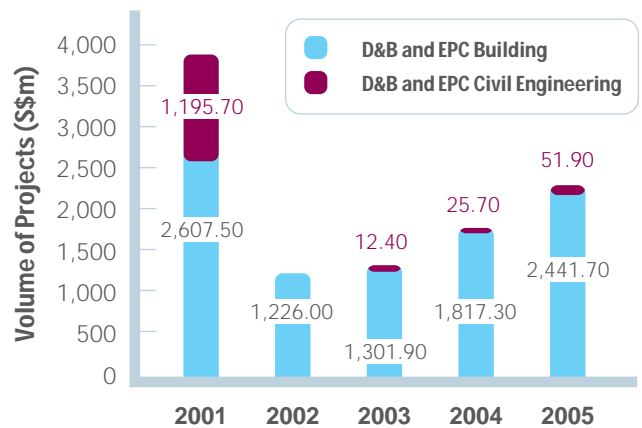

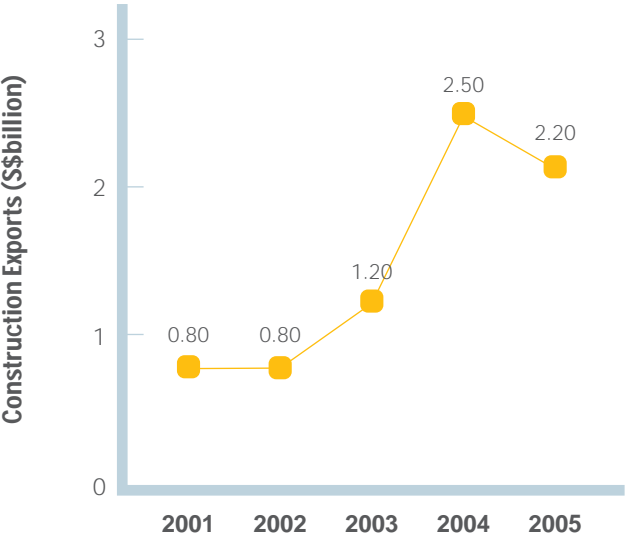

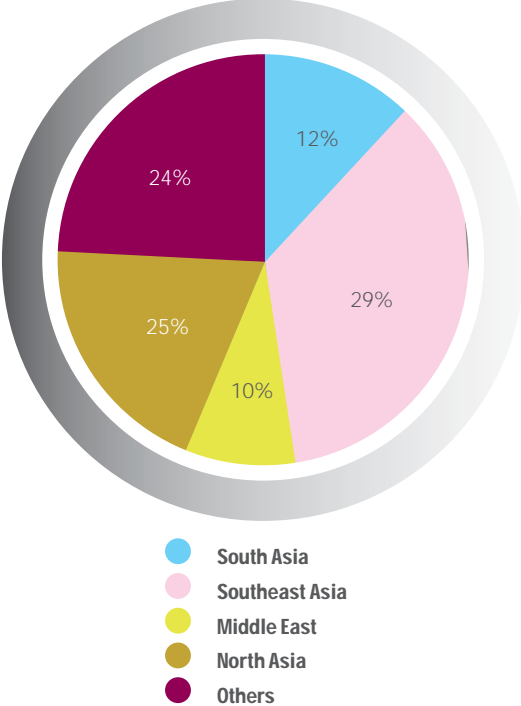
### Note:

The equipment and machinery constitute a substantial portion of the total project cost.

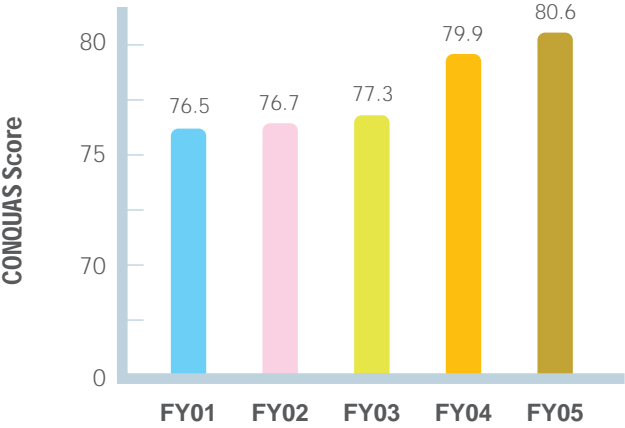

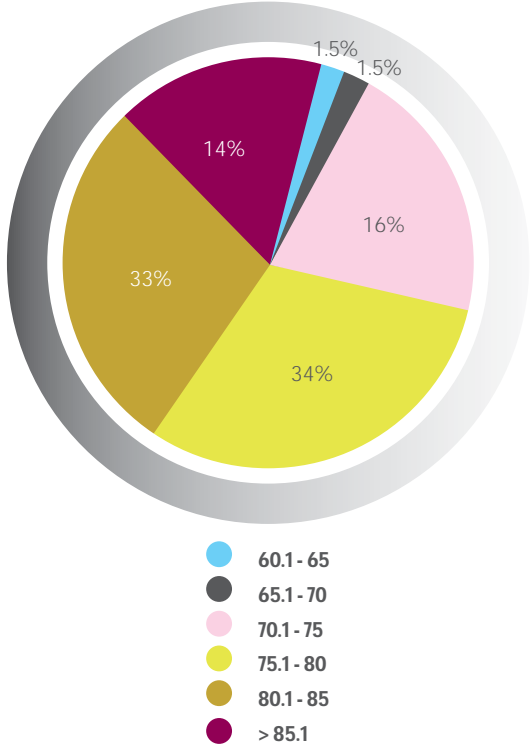

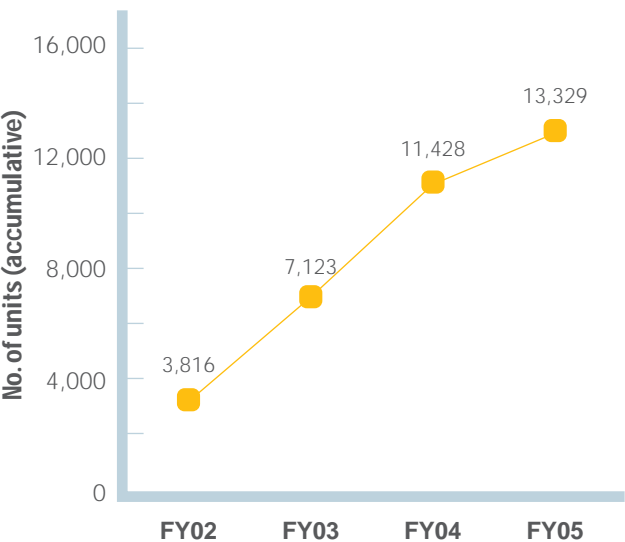
**Average CONQUAS Score**



**Distribution of CONQUAS Score in FY2005**

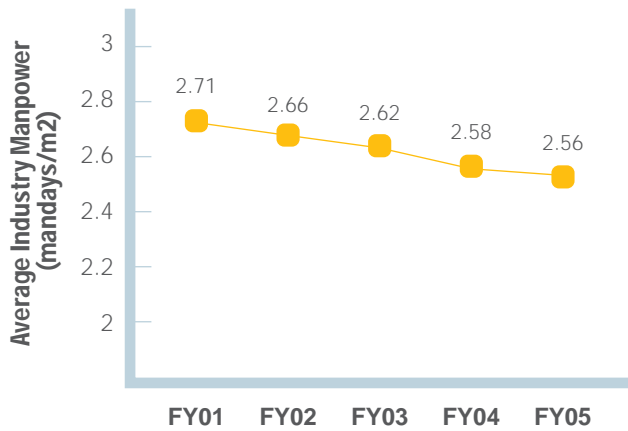


**Number of Quality Mark Residential Units**



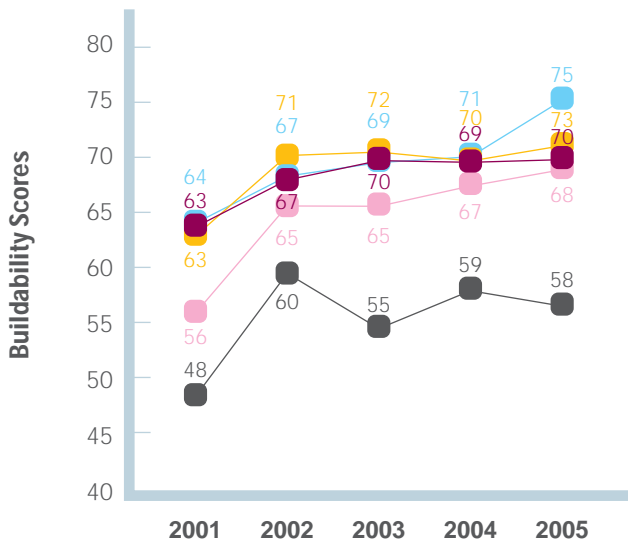

## Physical Productivity



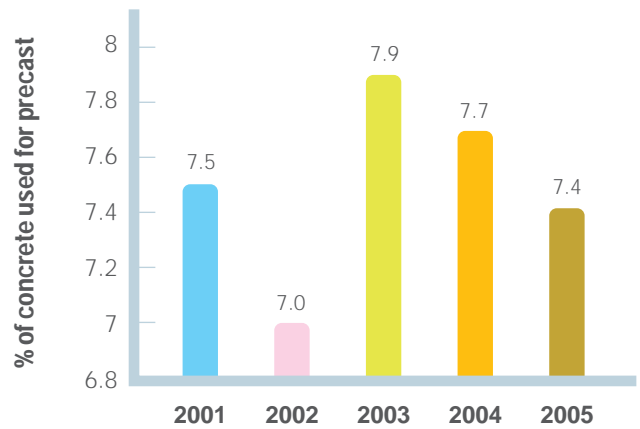

## Average Buildability Scores

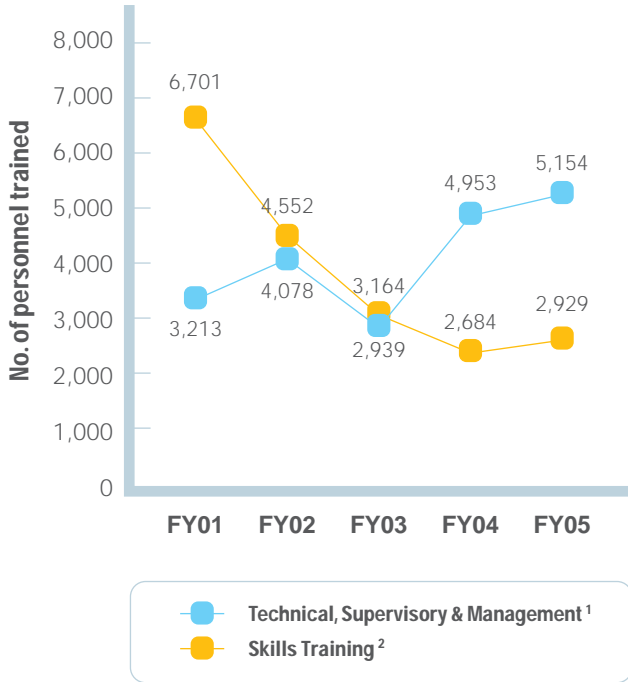

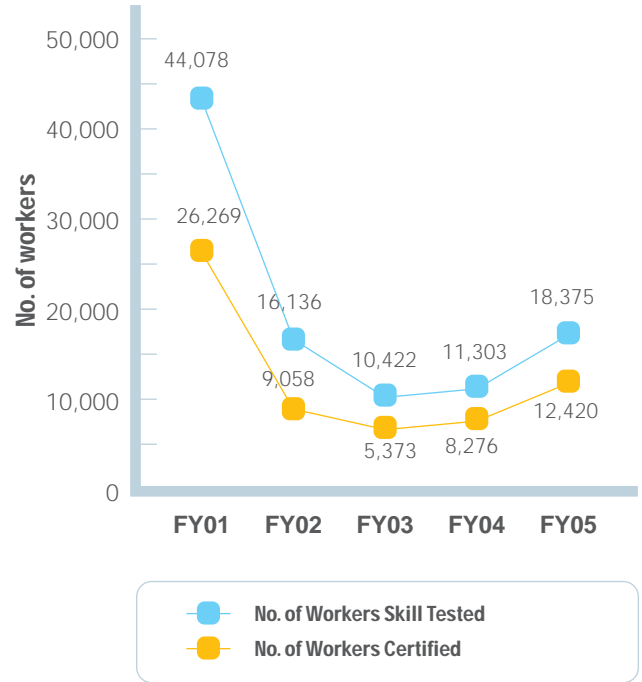
